DEADLINE FOR ABSTRACTS IS MAY 29, 2017

PRESENTATION CRITERIA

- ◆ Presentations should not exceed 50 minutes (including time for introductions and evaluations). If your presentation exceeds one hour, note this time on your proposal.
- ◆ Only educational content should be submitted for consideration. No abstracts will be accepted if they include marketing material or content. Identify the technical level of your presentation as basic, intermediate, or advanced.
- ◆ Presentations will be selected based on the following criteria:
 - ◇ Appeal of the subject matter
 - ◇ Technical merit
 - ◇ Originality of content and materials
 - ◇ Quality of content addressing multiple levels of expertise
 - ◇ Demonstration of useful tools to implement in the MS4 environment
 - ◇ Creative ideas for regulators.
